Syrian NGOs (SNGOs) were established in response to the need for humanitarian assistance inside Syria and also meet the needs of Refugees in neighboring countries post March 2011. Some SNGOs felt the need for a body where common advocacy messages relating to humanitarian issues are being agreed. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) saw the light on the 2nd April 2014 in Gaziantep, Turkey.

Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) Advocacy Meetings and Activities

SNA participates and attends several periodic and scheduled meetings, including HLG, ICCG, SSG, NGO Forum GA meeting, NGO Forum Advocacy Group Meeting, PAWG meeting of SIRF, ARCS and Interaction, following up on updated contexts that support the mandate of the SNA, providing updates on the context, funding, access, coordination, joint planning, Emergency Planning, Contingency Planning, the main gaps and challenges as well as the access challenges, key questions, recommendations and response pertaining the Earthquake, the legality of the Cross-border operations along with the upcoming Brussels conference along with getting the most important messages of advocacy and products to be worked on while helping stakeholders better understand SNGOs' perspectives on the current situation and priorities.

On June 2nd, SNA attended a meeting with representatives of IRC New York, briefed about SNA role and most important works, discussed both party advocacy efforts in term of XB UNSCR, main goal is to achieve 12 months renewal, as well as the advocacy products both parties are finalizing around the same subject.

Between June 10 and 12, SNA attended the Syrian Civil Society Networks Platform (SCNP) quarterly meeting held in Brussels, where the workshop aimed at providing a platform for exchange that enables participants to share information, experiences and knowledge related to Syria's Early Recovery and Recovery. By promoting collective learning, it aimed at generating common messages that can effectively engage international stakeholders.

In coordination with SCNP, SNA managed to organize two side events in Brussels prior to Brussels Seven Conference entitled: The Future of Syria and the Region:

- The first side event, entitled: <u>Building resilience</u> and ensuring accountability: Towards a principled approach to Syria's early recovery and recovery in Syria, held on 12 June.
- The second side event, entitled "<u>Cross-border</u> humanitarian assistance", held on 13 June.

On June 15th, SNA attended the Seventh Brussels Conference entitled: The Future of Syria and the Region.

On June 15th, SNA attended a hybrid briefing hosted by IRC and Co-penholders (Brazil and Switzerland), in the presence of E10 countries. SNA provided a summary of the importance of the Security Council resolution to local organizations, the importance of the United Nations coordinating mechanism's presence and its impact on security and safety in the region.

On June 20th, SNA attended a meeting hosted by OCHA and the ICCG platform, which mainly discussed the Action Plan/Contingency Plan for United Nations agencies if the UNSCR 2672 not renewed.
