




SNA EARTHQUAKE RESPONSE - SITREP #7 for JULY 2023

This report details the humanitarian responses of the Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) members during July 2023, encompassing both the general response and the post-earthquake response. The report focuses on three sectors: Food Security and Livelihoods (FSL), Water,

Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH), and Early Recovery. For data related to the Education, Nutrition, and Protection sectors, please refer to SitRep6. The list of SNA members who provided response data for this report can be found in the footer of each sector.

FOOD SECURITY & LIVELIHOODS (FSL)

- In July, members of the SNA reached a wide range of beneficiaries through their FSL interventions, targeting various groups such as adults, children, individuals with disabilities, and female-headed households.
- 248,840 households were reached encompassing 1,244,916 individuals. Although the reported number of members is lower than in June, there has been an increase of 68,584 households. 1,157,502 of these individuals were unique to the month of July while, the rest had received similar assistance in the previous month.
- Beneficiaries reached included 41% Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) and 59% mix of Host Communities & IDPs.
- To ensure that assistance provided aligned with the specific needs and contexts of the beneficiaries, both in-kind services and cash/voucher aid were utilized.





























WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE (WASH)

- SNA members conducted WASH projects in 368 camps, 3 shared shelters, and 22 schools. They focused mainly on working in camps, which was an increase compared to their activities in June.
- Through water infrastructure projects, SNA members delivered a total of 600,591 cubic meters of water. The entire operation utilized 23,178 litters of fuel throughout the month.
- Through water trucking, SNA members delivered 600,207 cubic meters of water and reached 514.224 beneficiaries.
- Water treatment procedures were carried out in 4,913 households.
- Within the scope of sanitation, 1,820 new toilets were installed, and 13,457 hygiene
 kits were distributed. Regular maintenance and cleaning of the toilets was undertaken,
 ensuring sanitary and accessible facilities for 63,516 beneficiaries, of which 214 were
 individuals with disabilities.




Water Infrastructure

Total beneficiaries reached by sewage infrastructure























EARLY RECOVERY


- SNA members conducted Early Recovery projects in 39 communities in Idleb and Aleppo Governorates.
- SNA members reached and assisted 1,119,429 beneficiaries (directly and indirectly) during July 2023.
- Early Recovery projects have reached individuals, including 892,019 individuals through the Earthquake Response initiative which increased by almost 200K when comparing with June despite having fewer members reporting than we did in June.
- .158,772 people were reached through activities under Maintenance and Improvement of Equitable Access to Basic Services, and 68,823 individuals benefiting from enhanced access to Livelihoods and Job Opportunities.
- An additional 993,934 indirect beneficiaries benefited from the overall improved conditions and infrastructure stemming from early recovery projects such as the rehabilitation of local markets/warehouses and roads.
