### Background

Syrian NGOs (SNGOs) were established in response to the need for humanitarian assistance inside Syria and also meet the needs of Refugees in neighboring countries post March 2011. Some SNGOs felt the need for a body where common advocacy messages relating to humanitarian issues are being agreed. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) saw the light on the 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2014 in Gaziantep, Turkey.

**Expected Council Action**

In February, the Security Council is expected to hold a briefing, followed by closed the political process and the humanitarian situation in Syria.

**Key Recent Developments**

The political track in Syria remains at a standstill, and the Syrian Constitutional Committee since June 2022. Russia, a close ally of Syria, has been objecting to Geneva convening the Constitutional Committee, following Switzerland's imposition of sanctions in response to its invasion of Ukraine. In his remarks at the 21 December 2023 Council Syria, Special Envoy for Syria Geir O. Pedersen said that "[t]he blockage of the Committee for a year and a half—largely over what should be a secondary issue, —has sent the wrong signal and has been a setback". He added that "there is no
