Syrian NGOs (SNGOs) were established in response to the need for humanitarian assistance inside Syria and also meet the needs of Refugees in neighboring countries post March 2011. Some SNGOs felt the need for a body where common advocacy messages relating to humanitarian issues are being agreed. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) saw the light on the 2nd April 2014 in Gaziantep, Turkey.

SNA consists of 22 SNGOs who are some of the largest SNGOs working to meet the Humanitarian needs in line with international standards and protocols. SNA provides the umbrella for these SNGOs to coordinate and advocate common messages ensuring the voices of affected populations heard. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) Advocacy Activities

SNA participates and attends several periodic and scheduled meetings, including ICCG, NGO Forum GA meeting, SSG and HLG by SNA members' representatives, PAWG meeting of SIRF, Interaction, and SCNP following up on updated contexts that support the mandate of the SNA, providing updates on the context, funding, access, coordination, joint planning, Emergency Planning, Contingency Planning, upcoming conferences, and events including Brussel conference, Senor official meeting, Hear our voices, and the main gaps and challenges as well as the access challenges, along with products to be worked on while helping stakeholders better understand SNGOs' perspectives on the current situation and priorities.

On Feb 1, SNA Co-launched Localization Support Lab, supported by NEAR and hosted by VDSF Network and Violet Organization.

On February 6, SNA attended an event on the anniversary of the earthquake Hosted by SNL, with the support from "peace space "organization.

On Feb 7, SNA held press conference on the annual anniversary of the EQ in Azaz city, in the presence of the majority of SNA NGO-members representatives, Civil defence and journalists. Followed by a visit to photo exhibition hall. The conference started by a moment of silent in respect for the Earthquake victims of civilians and humanitarian workers, challenges and lesson learned.

On Feb 7, SNA represented by SNA's Coordinator Mr. Saria Akkad, participated in an article released by Al-Araby Journal, and briefed about the response of humanitarian NGOs to Earthquake disaster.

On Feb 8, SNA held a meeting with HI organization, in the presence of SNA NGO-members, discussion focused on SNA role and works, Localization, and expanding partnership.

On Feb 15, SNA attended a meeting hosted by Brussel conference organizers, discussion focused mainly on preparation for the conference.

On Feb 20, SNA held the fourth quarterly meetings for 2023, Key topics discussed in the meeting included: welcoming the new registered members, reviewing cumulative works noted on previous meeting, discussion and voting on term of reference and proposed amendments, in addition to a brief from hosting organization.

On Feb 21, SNA met with Mentor initiative, discussion briefed about both Parties role and works, other network and alliance roles and different mandates and ways of coordination, main advocacy topics, MI efforts and focuses especially their role on WASH and Health sector.

On Feb 26, SNA attended a meeting with a rep of the Syrian Interim Government, meeting hosted by OCHA / AWG to discuss cooperation between SIG and Syrian NGOS.

On Feb 28, SNA hosted an information session in coordination with Center of humanitarian leadership, in the presence of interested members, the session briefed about the center and training sessions conducted by Crisis leadership program which aims to support various experiences of humanitarian workers.
