

Syrian NGO Alliance statement about the massive earthquake hit southern side of Turkey and Northern Syria

A 7.8 magnitude earthquake hit central and southern side of Turkey, and Northern Syria causing a massive destruction that toppled hundreds of buildings and claimed lives of hundreds of people in the area, and leaving many injured while hundreds are still trapped under collapsed buildings. The number of those who died is expected to rise as rescue teams still searching for survivors among the collapsed buildings.

We extend our condolences and express solidarity to the families of those who lost their lives in Syria and to the Turkish nation. And announcing our stand with the victims' families after this massive disaster.

Syrian NGO Alliance call upon the international committee, Country, Regional, Local and international donors to immediately respond and fund the related humanitarian sector especially health and protection to maintain and provide every kind of aids to this Catastrophic and urgent situation. And launch emergency allocation funds to support the humanitarian NGOs to act immediately and mitigate any further shocks.
