

Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) Statement Targeting Several Camps on the Outskirts of Idlib City

Residents of Idlib woke up to a new massacre on Sunday morning, November 6, 2022. Four camps were reportedly targeted on the outskirts of Idlib, in Northwest Syria.

The targeting was also reported to have been carried out by surface missiles, followed by several air strikes. As a result of the attacks, 10 civilians, mostly camp residents who were forcibly displaced, were killed, including four children and a woman, while more than 75 were wounded. In addition, according to medical and media sources, dozens of homes and tents were destroyed and burnt and hundreds of families were displaced.

Another massacre of civilians and vulnerable persons by Syrian and Russian forces in Northwest Syria; What made the crime worse is the usage of internationally prohibited weapons to target camps inhabited by civilians displaced from their homes due to similar attacks. More than 4.6 million people live in Northwest Syria, 1.8 million of whom live in camps, mostly women and children.

The Syrian NGO Alliance extends its deepest condolences to the families of the martyrs and the wounded and prays to God Almighty that the martyrs' families will be granted patience and tranquility in their suffering.

In the strongest terms, it also denounces and condemns the persistence of these violations and the use of internationally prohibited weapons against civilians without being held accountable by international actors.

The Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) calls on the International Community and Security Council States to act immediately to stop the targeting of civilians and to hold those responsible accountable for these violations and other violations against civilians, vulnerable displaced persons, and camps' residents.

We also call for sending international investigative missions to put an end to these violations and pressure all parties to the conflict to commit to neutralizing civilians from their conflict in Syria.
